Biodiversity	Grow more plants (so we get more insects) by cleaning up the nature garden.	More flowering plants high in nectar grow in the school grounds, which means insect numbers increase.	By summer 2022	Eco Committee pupils with Fiona Banks & Class Teachers	
	Plant flowers with lots of nectar. In the planters and greenhouse.	More wild plants/ flowers grow in the school grounds.	By May 2021		
	Seed Gathering Day – and plant them in the spring. Make seed bombs	Seeds are gathered in the autumn and distributed in the spring, giving them a better chance to survive, leading to more seedlings.	Gather by Nov 2021 and release seeds by May 2022.	Nursery, P1-4, Class Teachers, Fiona Banks	
	Build bird feeders & bug houses.	Insects have places to overwinter. Birdfeeders encourage birds to stay in the school grounds.	Replace/ repair bird feeders and bug hotel by Dec 2021	Janitor, Fiona Banks, P5-7 pupils.
